

# Australian Contingent to 12<sup>th</sup> New Zealand Venture Venture South – Riverton Southland

4 to 15 January 2013 Optional Pre-Tour: 27 Dec 2012 to 4 Jan 2013

## The Plan

In 2010, 330 Australians went to the last New Zealand Venture and had the time of their lives. In 2013 we plan to do the same again, but this time pack in even more action and adventure!

## The Pre Tour - 27 December 2012 to 4 January 2013

The optional pre tour is one of the most exciting aspects of the trip.

## 27 December

The Contingent travels from each capital city in Australia and arrives in Auckland at the top of the North Island. Today we will stay just outside of Auckland.

## 28 December

Today we travel from Auckland to Rotorua. The trip is around 3 hours, and we will stop to take in an activity and lunch on the way. Once at Rotorua we will setup camp for the next two days and then head to the Tamaki Maori Village to take in some Maori culture and to participate in a Hangi, a traditional Maori meal.

#### 29 December

Today we head to Hells Gate - the beast of all Geothermal Parks at Rotorua. Here you will be able to see the amazing Geothermal activity, participate in a guided tour, hear about the culture and take in a mud bath and spa.

After Hells Gate we head to AgroVentures where you will be to participate in Jetboating, simulated free fall, the Swoop swing, plus many other activities.

## 30 December

Today we travel from Rotorua to Hamilton, about 1.5 hours by bus. We will be staying here for the next two days, and will be doing various local activities.

## 31 December

There will be a range of local activities on offer today plus a massive New Years Eve party!

## 1 January

We leave Hamilton today and head to Auckland Airport. From here, smaller groups will fly down to Queenstown, our base for the next few days. In Queenstown we will be staying at Reavers Lodge, a ski lodge about 400m walk from the centre of Queenstown.

#### 2 to 4 January

You will have 3 full days in Queenstown and will be able to pick your activities including Jet Boating, The Nevis Swing - the worlds biggest swing, White Water Rafting, Amazing Race, Extreme Mountain Biking, Gondola's and Luge, Kayaking, the must see Milford Sound, plus others. The non pre tour group will also be joining us on the 4

## **5 January**

Today we leave Queenstown and head to the Venture site at Riverton near Invercargill. From here the Venture commences.







## Venture South - 5 January to 15 January 2013

Venture South is the reason we are all doing this, its the 12th New Zealand Venture and will have around 500 Kiwis plus 300 Aussies. The Venture is split into two components, being Expeditions or Phase 1 as they call it, and the Off & On Site activities known as Phase 2.

For the expeditions, you get to choose 3 preferences when you register and you will hopefully receive one of these 3. The expedition phase is 5 days and you will be in expedition units of 8 to 9 Venturers with 1 Unit Leader. You will head off into all different locations in the lower South Island of New Zealand.

After expeditions are done you will head back to the Venture site and will camp with your expedition unit but will be able to see all of your mates again. There will be a range of on and off-site activities which you can participate in.

## **Expeditions - Phase 1**

In units of 8 to 9 Venturers and 1 Leader you will head off on Expeditions all over the South Island. You get to choose 3 preferences for your Expedition and all going well you will receive one of these three. You will find out what expedition you have received during the year prior to the Venture.

Expeditions will include Tramping (what Kiwis call Hiking), Scuba Diving, Queenstown Adrenaline Base (not recommended if you are doing the Aussie pre tour as some activities will be duplicated), The Amazing Race, and Kayaking to name a few. More expeditions will be announced at the end of March 2012.



#### Back on site - Phase 2

The New Zealand organising team have been busy finalising Phase 1 expeditions and not much information is available yet on Phase 2 yet, but at the last New Zealand Venture Phase 2 activities included Paint Ball, Abseiling, Shooting, Rock Climbing, Golf, Ten Pin Bowling, town shuttle bus, just to name a few. Evening activities included Region vs Region, bands & DJs, carnival night, casino night, and comedy night.





## **Travel Details**

## **Contingent Travel**

The Australian Contingent will be offering flights from Melbourne, Sydney, Brisbane, Adelaide, Darwin and Perth to New Zealand. If you live in another area, talk to us and we may be able to include a connecting flight for a small additional fee.

To move such a large Contingent we need to use multiple airlines and smaller travel groups. Within Australia we are using Qantas, and on the international leg we are primarily using Emirates on their Airbus A380 and Boeing 777-300ER aircraft from all ports except Perth. Perth members will fly direct with Air New Zealand. Domestically within New Zealand we are using Air New Zealand and Jetstar.

Due to the complexities of large group travel, you are not able to use frequent flyer points to subsidise your travel. You can earn points if you redeem them after you fly.

More specific travel details including departure and arrival times will be provide at the orientation days.

At no point is the Contingent visiting or travelling through Christchurch.

## **Independent Travel**

We strongly prefer that all members travel with the Contingent to and from Australia.

If you are planning a family holiday and wish to stay on after the Venture or before it, we are prepared to consider independent travel on this basis. If approved, you would need to meet us at a designated point at a designated time. There will be no flexibility in this arrangement due to the large groups we are moving.

During the online signup there is an opportunity to request independent travel.

All independent travel MUST be approved by the Contingent leader.

## **Travel Surcharge**

Due to the increased airfares when travelling from some Australian capital cities to New Zealand, it has been necessary to place a surcharge on some members attending from non east coast capital cities.

The surcharge varies depending on if you are doing the pre tour or not. This is due to differences in airfares based on the day of travel.

Must be a registered and invested Venturer, and hold the Venturering Skills Award Must be recommended by their Venturer Leader, Group Leader & District Commissioner

Must be accepted by the Australian Contingent

**Leaders** Be a registered Leader holding a Certificate of Adult Leadership with Scouts Australia

It is preferred that Leaders be Leaders of Youth within the Venturer Section Must be endorsed by your Group, District, Region and Chief Commissioner

Must be accepted by the Australian Contingent
